Information You Provide Directly

- Any other information you voluntarily provide

Information Collected Automatically

When you visit our website, we may automatically collect:

- IP address
- Browser type and version
- Device information
- Pages visited
- Time spent on pages
- Website usage data through cookies or analytics tools

4. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Respond to enquiries and communicate with you
- Provide our services
- Manage client relationships
- Improve our website and services
- Send relevant updates or marketing communications (where lawful)
- Maintain website security and performance
- Meet legal and regulatory obligations

5. Legal Basis for Processing

Under UK GDPR, we rely on the following lawful bases:

- **Consent** – where you have agreed to receive marketing communications
- **Contract** – where processing is necessary to provide services
- **Legitimate Interests** – to operate, improve and grow our business responsibly
- **Legal Obligation** – where we are required to comply with the law
